

## William O. Studeman, Admiral, USN (Ret)

Admiral Studeman, a Navy Intelligence (now Information Warfare) Professional, retired from the U.S. Navy in 1995 after 34 years of Service. His senior Flag positions included Director of Navy Long Range Planning, Director of Naval Intelligence, Director of the National Security Agency, and Deputy Director of Central Intelligence (Pre-DNI) with management oversight of the Intelligence Community and the Central Intelligence Agency.

After retirement, ADM Studeman worked for ten years as the VP/Deputy General Manager of Northrop Grumman Mission Systems. ADM Studeman has served on numerous university, corporate, laboratory and government Boards. Retired in Annapolis, Maryland, Admiral Studeman is currently *emeritus* on the Board of Annapolis Life Care LLC where he recently served as Board President and currently Chairs the Strategic Planning Committee of the Board. Coming from a large Pan American Airways family, ADM Studeman currently Chairs the Advisory Board of the Pan American Museum Foundation (PAMF) where his wife is a past Board Member. ADM Studeman is an Aviation Historian and currently conducts research on pre-WW-II aviation history from the Pacific area.

Admiral Studeman has been married to Diane Jeans of Hampshire, UK, for 61 years and they have three children Dr Kim Studeman of Mercy Hospital, RADM Mike Studeman, USN Ret and China Specialist, and Kate Studeman, SETA to the Space Acquisition Agency, and four grandboys.
